



How to Sort for Recycling Drop Off at the Hub

This quick guide touches on major points with recycling at the Hub. The full picture of everything we accept can be found at www.cintirrh.org

Soft Plastics

Soft plastics are sorted into the flexible film or the store drop off collection. Store Drop Off is the stricter collection for quality control. When in doubt, check with a volunteer or tuck into the flexible film collection.

Rigid Plastics

Plastics are sorted by whether they are rigid or soft/flexible. Rigid plastics are then sorted by # into corresponding bins. Please note the various curbside items that should not be dropped off at the Hub.

#1 PET or PETE (no bottles, no cups, no jugs)	#2 HDPE (no bottles, no tubs, no jugs)	#3 PVC (no bottles, no cups, no jugs)	#4 LDPE (no bottles, no tubs, no jugs)
#5 PP (no bottles, no cups, no jugs)	#6 PS (no food styrofoam in this bin)	#7 ABS, PLA, and OTHER (no bottles, no cups, no jugs)	NO # small and large item bins
